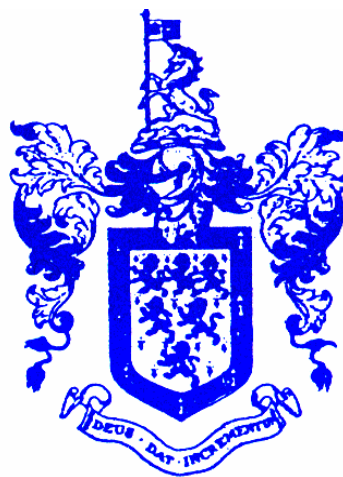

**WARRINGTON SWIMMING CLUB  
CONSTITUTIONAL RULES**

**1 NAME**

1.1 The name of the club shall be The Warrington Swimming Club.

**2 AIMS**

- 2.1 The aims of the club shall be to:-
- 2.1.1 Promote the teaching and the practice of swimming.
  - 2.1.2 Promote the teaching and the practice of the game of Water Polo.
  - 2.1.3 Promote and conduct annually swimming championships.
  - 2.1.4 Raise public awareness of the sport and stimulate public opinion in favour of providing suitable accommodation and facilities.

**3 OBJECTIVES**

- 3.1 In the furtherance of the aims of the Club the following objectives shall be undertaken:-
- 3.1.1 The club is committed to treat everyone equally within the context of their activity, regardless of sex, ethnic origin, religion, disability, political persuasion or age.
  - 3.1.2 The club believes that the welfare of children is the responsibility of everyone and that all children and young people have a right to have fun, be safe and be protected from harm.
- 3.2 The club shall be affiliated to the Northern Counties Amateur Swimming Association and shall adopt and conform to the rules of the Northern Counties Amateur Swimming Association and such other bodies as the club may determine from time to time.
- 3.3 The business affairs of the club shall at all times be conducted in accordance with the Laws and Technical Rules of the Amateur Swimming Association (ASA Laws) and in particular :-
- 3.3.1 all competing members shall be eligible competitors as defined in ASA Law;
  - 3.3.2 the club shall in accordance with ASA Law adopt the ASA Child Protection Procedures;
  - 3.3.3 members of the club shall, in accordance with ASA Laws, comply with the ASA Child Protection Procedures.
- 3.4 By virtue of the affiliation of the Club to the Northern Counties District the Club and all members of the Club shall acknowledge that they are subject to the laws and rules of :-
- 3.4.1 the Cheshire County Water Polo and Swimming Association;
  - 3.4.2 the Northern Counties District;
  - 3.4.3 the Amateur swimming Association; to include the ASA/ISTC Code of ethics;
  - 3.4.4 the Amateur Swimming Federation of Great Britain, to include in particular the ASFGB Doping Control Rules and Protocols and ASFGB Disciplinary Code;
  - 3.4.5 FINA, the world governing body for the sport of swimming in all its disciplines, together with the Governing Body Rules.
- 3.5 In the event that there shall be any conflict between any rule or by-law of the Club and any of the Governing Body Rules then the relevant Governing Body Rules shall prevail.

**4 COMMITTEE**

- 4.1 The Committee shall consist of:-
- The Chairman
  - The Vice Chairman
  - The Hon. Treasurer
  - The Hon. Secretary
  - The Hon. Membership Secretary
  - The Hon. Water Polo Secretary
  - The Hon. Swimming Coach
  - The Hon. Water Polo Coach
  - Eight other elected members
- all of whom must be members of the Club.
- 4.2 All committee members must be not less than 18 years of age.
- 4.3 The Committee members shall be proposed, seconded and elected by ballot at the Annual General meeting each year and shall remain in office until their successors are elected at the next Annual General Meeting. Retiring members of the Committee shall be eligible for re-election. The Committee may fill any vacancy occurring by resignation or by any other means.
- 4.4 In the event of any member of the Committee not attending four consecutive Committee meetings, it shall be considered equivalent to their resignation and the Committee shall proceed to fill the vacancy, unless the Committee are satisfied that such absence is unavoidable and have been notified of the same.
- 4.5 Committee meetings shall be held not less than once per month, save where the Committee itself shall by a simple majority resolve not to meet. The quorum for a Committee meeting shall be seven members, to include not less than one Officer. The Chairman and the Hon. Secretary shall have discretion to call further meetings of the Committee if they consider it to be in the interests of the Club.
- 4.6 The Hon. Secretary shall give all the members of the Committee not less than seven days notice of a meeting.
- 4.7 Decisions of the Committee shall be made by a simple majority of the votes cast. Each member present, with the exception of the Chairman, or the acting Chairman, for that meeting shall have one vote. In the event of equality of votes the Chairman, or the acting Chairman for that meeting, shall have a casting vote.
- 4.8 The Hon. Secretary, or in the absence of the Hon. Secretary a member of the Committee, shall take the minutes of the meeting.
- 4.9 In the event that a quorum is not present within thirty minutes of the published start, a meeting shall stand adjourned to the time and date falling seven days after the date of the meeting, or such other date and time as may be determined by the Chairman. If a quorum is not present at the adjourned meeting then those Committee members attending may act for the purpose of calling a Special General Meeting of the members, to which the provisions as to the minimum notice contained in Rule 7.1 shall not apply.

- 4.10 In addition to the members so elected the Committee may co-opt further members of the Club who shall serve until the next Annual General Meeting. Co-opted members shall be entitled to vote at the meetings of the Committee and shall not be counted in establishing whether a quorum is present.
- 4.11 The Committee may from time to time appoint from among its members such sub-committee or working groups as it may consider necessary and may delegate to them such of the powers and duties of the Committee as the Committee may determine. All sub-committees and working groups shall have one Officer in its membership and shall periodically report their proceedings to the Committee and shall conduct their business in accordance with the directions of the Committee. The Committee shall determine the terms of reference of any such sub-committee or working groups.
- 4.12 The Committee shall be responsible for the management of the Club and shall have the sole right of appointment and determining the terms and conditions of service of employees of the Club. The Committee shall have the power to enter into contracts for the purpose of the Club on behalf of all the members of the Club. The Committee shall be responsible for ensuring that two independent Auditors, to be elected by the members at the Annual General Meeting, examine the Accounts of the Club for each financial year.
- 4.13 The members of the Committee shall be indemnified by the members of the Club against all liabilities properly incurred by them in the management of the affairs of the Club.

## **5 OFFICERS, HONORARY MEMBERS and LIFE MEMBERS**

- 5.1 The Officers of the Club shall be the Chairman, the Vice Chairman, the Hon. Treasurer and the Hon. Secretary.
- 5.2 The Officers of the Club shall be proposed, seconded and elected by ballot at the Annual General Meeting and shall hold office until the next Annual General Meeting when they shall retire. Any retiring officer shall be eligible for re-election. The Committee may fill any vacancy occurring by resignation or by any other means.
- 5.3 The Annual General Meeting of the Club may elect a President and Vice-Presidents. A President or Vice-President need not be a member of the Club and on election shall, ex officio, be an Honorary Member of the Club and must be included in the Club's Annual Return of Members to the ASA.
- 5.4 The Committee may elect any person as an Honorary Member of the Club for such period as they may think fit and they shall be entitled to all the privileges of membership except that they shall not be entitled to vote at meetings and serve as Officers or on the Committee unless any such person shall have retained in addition their ordinary membership of the Club. Such Honorary Members must be included in the Club's Annual Return of Members to the ASA.
- 5.5 On the recommendation of the Committee the Annual General Meeting may as they see fit elect as Life Members any member of the Club whose services to the Club are considered to entitle them to that recognition. Such life members must be included in the Club's Annual Return of Members to the ASA.

## **6 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING**

- 6.1 The Annual General Meeting of the Club shall be held in November each year. The Committee shall fix the date of the Annual General Meeting.
- 6.2 The purpose of the Annual General Meeting is to transact the following business:-
- 6.2.1 to receive the Chairman's report of the activities of the Club during the previous year;
  - 6.2.2 to receive and consider; the accounts of the Club for the previous year, the report on the accounts by the independent Auditors and the Treasurer's report as to the financial position of the Club;
  - 6.2.3 to receive and comment on the reports of the Hon. Swimming Coach and the Hon. Water Polo Coach for the activities of the Club during the previous year,
  - 6.2.4 to receive and comment on the reports of the delegates to each of the Organisations and Associations to which the Club is affiliated,
  - 6.2.5 to remove and elect the two independent Auditors, who must not be members of the Committee,
  - 6.2.6 to elect the President, the Officers and the other members of the Committee,
  - 6.2.7 to decide on any other resolution that may be duly submitted in accordance with Rule 6.4.
- 6.3 Nominations for election of members to the position of President, to any office or to membership of the Committee shall be made in writing by the proposer and seconder to the Hon. Secretary, not later than 21 days before the date of the Annual General Meeting.
- 6.4 Notice of any resolution proposed to be moved at the Annual General Meeting shall be given in writing to the Hon. Secretary not less than 21 days before the date of the Annual General Meeting.
- 6.5 The President, the Chairman, the Vice Chairman, the Honorary Offices and the other Members of the Committee shall retire from office at the Annual General Meeting each year, but shall be eligible for re-election.

## **7 SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING**

- 7.1 A Special General Meeting may be called at any time by the Committee. A Special General Meeting shall be called by the Hon. Secretary within 28 days of receipt of a requisition in writing signed by not less than ten members entitled to attend and vote at a General Meeting stating the purposes for which the meeting is required and the resolutions proposed.

## **8 PROCEDURES at the ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING and any SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING**

- 8.1 The Hon. Secretary shall be responsible for providing each Senior Member and Life Member of the Club written notice of the date, time and place of the Annual General Meeting or a Special General Meeting together with the resolutions to be proposed, at least fourteen days before the date of the meeting and in the case of the Annual General Meeting a list of the nominees for the Committee posts and a copy of the examined accounts. The notice of the meeting shall in addition, wherever possible, be displayed on the Club Notice Board.
- 8.2 All business of an Annual General Meeting or of a Special General Meeting shall be printed on the agenda and no other motion shall be discussed therein except :-
- 8.2.1 to record the name of the Chairman,

- 8.2.2 to record the name of the Secretary,
- 8.2.3 for adjournment,
- 8.2.4 for leave to withdraw a motion,
- 8.2.5 for a vote of thanks,
- 8.2.6 for permission to withdraw.

- 8.3 The quorum for the Annual General meeting and any Special General Meeting shall be ten members entitled to attend and vote at the meeting, which must contain not less than one Officer.
- 8.4 Each member present and entitled to vote, with the exception of the Chairman, shall have one vote and a simple majority shall pass resolutions. In the event of an equality of votes the Chairman shall have a casting vote. Senior Members and Life Members shall be entitled to be heard and to vote on all matters. Junior Members shall be entitled to be heard and vote only on those matters determined by the Chairman as matters concerning juniors.
- 8.5 The Chairman, or in the absence of the Chairman, a member selected by the Committee, shall take the chair.
- 8.6 The Hon. Secretary, or in the absence of the Hon. Secretary a member of and selected by the Committee, shall take minutes.
- 8.7 The Chairman shall at all General Meetings have unlimited authority upon every question of order and shall be, for the purpose of such meetings, the sole interpreter of the Rules of the Club.

## **9 TRUSTEES**

- 9.1 The Trustees shall be the Chairman, the Hon. Secretary and the Hon. Treasurer of the Club during their respective terms of office.
- 9.2 Any of the club's trophies not being competed for shall be lodged with the Hon. Treasurer or other such person as nominated by the Committee for safekeeping.

## **10 FINANCES**

- 10.1 All moneys payable to the Club shall be received by the Treasurer and deposited in a bank account in the name of the Club. No sum above £10 shall be drawn from that account except by cheque signed by two of the three signatories who shall be the Chairman, Hon. Secretary and Hon. Treasurer.
- 10.2 The income and property of the Club shall be applied only in furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Club and no part thereof shall be paid by way of bonus, dividend or profit to any members of the Club, save as set out in Rule 10.3.
- 10.3 The Committee shall have the power to authorise the payment of remuneration and expenses to any officer, member or employee of the Club and to any other person or persons for services rendered to the Club.
- 10.4 The financial transactions of the Club shall be recorded by the Treasurer in such a manner as the Committee think fit.
- 10.5 The financial year of the Club shall be the period commencing on 1st October and ending on 30th September. Any change to the financial year shall require the approval of the members in a General Meeting.

## **11 AUDITORS**

- 11.1 Two Hon. Auditors shall be appointed at the Annual General Meeting, they shall audit the annual statement of the accounts and the balance sheet and shall certify the same before they are printed.

## **12 MEMBERSHIP**

- 12.1 The total membership of the Club shall not normally be limited. If however the Committee considers that there is good reason to impose any limit from time to time then the Committee shall put forward appropriate proposals for consideration at a General Meeting of the Club. The members shall have the right to impose and remove from time to time any limits on total membership, or any category of membership, of the Club.
- 12.2 Any person who wishes to become a member of the Club must submit a signed application to the Hon. Secretary. In the case of application for junior membership the parent or guardian of the applicant must sign the application.
- 12.3 Election to membership shall be at the discretion of the Committee or other person(s) authorised by the Committee. The Committee or other such authorised person(s) shall not be required to give reasons for the refusal of any application for membership.
- 12.4 Club membership shall consist of Senior Members, Junior Members, Honorary Members and Life Members. A member shall be a Junior until the 1st. January in the year in which the seventeenth birthday occurs, when they shall become a Senior Member.
- 12.5 Life Membership may be awarded at the Annual General Meeting in recognition of services rendered to the Club. Such nominations for the award to be presented by and on behalf of the Committee.

## **13 SUBSCRIPTIONS and OTHER FEES**

- 13.1 The annual subscription for members, and other fees as applicable, shall be determined from time to time by the Committee and the Committee shall in so doing make special provision for different classes of membership as it shall determine.
- 13.2 The annual subscription shall be due on joining the Club and thereafter on the 1st January of each year.
- 13.3 Any member whose subscription is unpaid by 1st March may be suspended by the Committee from some or all Club activities from a date to be determined by the Committee and until such payment is made.
- 13.4 The Committee shall, from time to time, have the power to determine the annual membership subscription and any other fees. This shall not include the power to make such increases in the subscription as shall be consequential upon an increase in individual ASA membership fees. Any increase in subscriptions shall be advised to the members in writing with the reasons for any increase to be reported to the members at the next Annual General Meeting.

## **14 RESIGNATION**

- 14.1 A member wishing to resign membership of the Club shall give to the Hon. Secretary written notice of his resignation.

A member's resignation shall only take effect when Rule 14.1 has been complied with.

- 14.2 Notwithstanding the provisions of Rule 14.1 above, a member whose subscription is more than three months in arrear shall be deemed to have resigned. Where the membership of a member shall be terminated in this way he shall be informed in writing that he is no longer a member .

## **15 EXPULSION and other DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

- 15.1 The Committee shall have the power to expel a member when, in its opinion, it would not be in the interests of the Club to retain the membership of the person.
- 15.2 The Club shall adopt and comply with the ASA Guidelines for handling Internal Club Disputes (the Guidelines) as the same may be revised from time to time. The Guidelines are set out as an Appendix to the ASA Judicial Laws and appear in the ASA Handbook.
- 15.3 A member may not be expelled or (subject to Rule 15.4 below) be made the subject of any other penalty unless the panel hearing the complaint shall, by a two-thirds majority, vote in favour of the expulsion or other penalty imposed upon the member.
- 15.4 The Officers of the Club, or any other person to whom the Committee shall delegate this power, may temporarily suspend or exclude a member from particular training sessions and/or wider club activities, when in their opinion, such action is in the interests of the Club. Where such action is taken the complaint will therefore be dealt with in accordance with the Guidelines.

## **16 COMPETITION**

- 16.1 No person shall be allowed to compete for the Club unless they are a member of the Club.

## **17 CLUB CERTIFICATE**

- 17.1 Any Member instrumental in saving a human life from drowning may at the discretion of the General Committee be awarded the Club's Medal.

## **18 CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- 18.1 The rules governing the Club Championships are deemed not to be part of the Constitutional Rules of the Club.

## **19 TROPHIES**

- 19.1 All trophies of The Warrington Swimming Club shall be considered "Perpetual" unless the donor at the time of giving the trophy specifies otherwise.

## **20 INTERPRETATION OF RULES**

- 20.1 In the event of any question arising as to the correct interpretation of these rules, or to any one of them, or any other question not herein provided for, such questions shall be referred to the Committee, whose decision shall be final.

## **21 ALTERATION of the RULES and other RESOLUTIONS**

- 21.1 The rules may be altered by a resolution passed at an Annual General Meeting provided that the resolution is carried by a majority of at least two-thirds of the members present and entitled to vote at the Annual General Meeting.
- 21.2 Any member entitled to attend and vote at a General Meeting shall be entitled to put any proposal for consideration at any General Meeting provided the proposal in writing is lodged with the Hon. Secretary of the Club not later than 1st November in the case of the Annual General Meeting or in the case of a Special General Meeting 21 days before the date of the meeting and the Hon. Secretary shall supply a copy of the proposal or resolution to the members in the manner provided for in Rule 8.1.
- 21.3 The Championship Conditions shall not be considered part of the Constitutional Rules for the purpose of this rule.

## **22 STANDING ORDERS**

- 22.1 The Committee shall have power to make, repeal and amend such standing orders as they may from time to time consider necessary for the well being of the Club. The standing orders, repeals and amendments shall have effect until set aside by the Committee or at a General Meeting

## **23 DISSOLUTION**

- 23.1 A resolution to dissolve the Club shall only be proposed at a General Meeting and shall be carried by a majority of at least three-quarters of the members present and entitled to vote.
- 23.2 The dissolution shall have effect from the date of the resolution and members of the Committee shall be responsible for the winding-up of the assets and liabilities of the Club.
- 23.3 Any property remaining after the discharge of the debts and liabilities of the Club shall be given to a charity or charities, or other non-profit making organisation having similar objectives to those of the Club, for the furtherance of such objects, as nominated by the Committee.

## **24 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT**

- 24.1 The members acknowledge that these Rules constitute a legally binding contract to regulate the relationship of the members with each other and with the Club.

## SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIP AND AGE GROUP CONDITIONS

The Warrington Swimming Club Championship and Age Group Competition conditions are not part of the Constitutional Rules of the Club and are therefore published separately.

### **1 General Championship Conditions**

- 1.1 The Swimming Championships shall take place annually at venues and on dates decided by the General Committee.
- 1.2 The Championships shall normally take place in October of each year on dates to be decided by the General Committee.
- 1.3 Any alteration to the conditions of any Championship or any other competition shall be subject to approval by the General Committee.
- 1.4 Entry fees shall be as set by the General Committee.
- 1.5 All Championships events will be held in accordance with the appropriate ASA Laws and the ASA Technical Rule of Swimming.
- 1.6 The Club Championships shall be open to all members of the Club.
- 1.7 Any competitor failing to comply with any of the conditions may be disqualified and shall forfeit any fee paid.

### **2 Championship Entries**

- 2.1 Entries must be made on the official entry forms of the club to reach the Hon. Championship Secretary by the specified closing date, accompanied by the entry fee.
- 2.2 In the age group events the age shall be the age as at 31st December in the year of the competition.
- 2.3 In the case of entries to the Junior or the Age Group events the official declaration of the date of birth must be completed by the Parent or Guardian of the competitor.
- 2.4 Championship entry forms shall be made available no later than 1st July.
- 2.5 The closing date for entries shall be 8th September.
- 2.6 Late entries will not be accepted.

### **3 Championship Events**

- 3.1 Events shall be held in the following categories
  - i Senior Championships
  - ii 16 years and under (Junior) Championships
  - iii 14 years and under competitions
  - iv 12 years and under competitions.
  - v 10 years and under competitions
- 3.2 The General Committee shall be responsible for producing the programme of events with consideration being given to the number of entries in each event as to whether heats and finals are required.
- 3.3 Senior and Junior Championships are classed as separate competitions but are swum as a combined event, if heats are involved.
- 3.4 In all events having more than six competitors, a final will be swum with the six fastest competitors from the heats contesting the final.
- 3.5 The Junior Championship shall be awarded to the Junior swimmer with the fastest recorded time in the Championship.
- 3.6 If the first three places of any category are not decided in the Final then the final placing will be based on the fastest heat times of the non-finalists.

### **4 Definitions**

- 4.1 A Junior is one who is under 17 years of age on 31st December in the year of the competition.

### **5 Trophies**

- 5.1 Winners shall be entitled (subject to satisfactory guarantee to the trustees) to hold the respective trophies for the events up to one month before the next yearly competition. Upon expiration of this period or upon ceasing to be members of the Club trophies must be returned to the Hon. Championship Secretary

## ANNUAL AWARDS

### 1 CHAMPIONSHIP SWIMMER OF THE YEAR AWARDS

- 1.1 Four trophies shall be awarded in recognition of the success achieved during the year (1st November to 31st October) by swimmers participating in championships both of the Club and of the Associations to which the club is affiliated, one trophy is to be allocated to each of the following four groups:-
- i Junior Ladies
  - ii Senior Ladies
  - iii Junior Men
  - iv Senior Men
- 1.2 The awarding of trophies shall be on a points system taking into account the following events :-
- i Warrington Swimming Club Championships.
  - ii Bolton and District Swimming Championships.
  - iii Liverpool and District Swimming and Age Group Championships.
  - iv Cheshire County Swimming and Age Groups Championships.
  - v Northern Counties Swimming and Age Group Championships.
  - vi ASA Swimming Championships.
  - vii National Age Group Championships.
  - viii National Youth Championships.
- 1.3 Points shall be awarded as follows :-
- i Any record set in the above events 3 points
  - iii First place in any of the above events 5 points
  - v Second place in any of the above events 4 points
  - vi Third place in any of the above events 3 points
  - vii Finalist in any of the above events excluding 1st, 2nd, or 3rd 2 points
  - viii Qualifying time in any of the above events 1 point
- 1.4 The Championship Swimmer of the Year trophies awarded shall be as follows:-

- 1933 **Margaret Hallaway Trophy**  
Presented to the club by Mrs. Margaret Hallaway, wife of the then Town Clerk. Mr Hallaway served as Town Clerk of Warrington for the period 1918 - 1939.
- 1933 **The Wardonia Perpetual Trophy**  
Presented to the club by Thomas Ward Ltd. a well known company of Cutlers in Warrington at that time.
- 1947 **The Rowland Lord Memorial Trophy**  
Presented to the club by Mr. and Mrs. E.Lord in memory of their son Rowland, killed at sea in 1944. Rowland Lord was an outstanding swimmer in the club and winner of the Senior Mens Freestyle Championship of the club on five occasions from 1933 to 1937.
- 1949 **Mabel Briscoe Trophy**  
Presented to the Club by Major and Mrs. Briscoe. Major Briscoe was a prominent member of the town.
- 1951 **1951 Festival Trophy**  
Presented to the Club by Mrs.V.Dacey on behalf of the then Ladies Committee of the club in recognition of the Festival of Britain celebration and allocated to the Ladies 100 metres Breaststroke event.
- 1951 **1951 Festival Trophy**  
Presented to the Club by Mrs.V.Dacey on behalf of the then Ladies Committee of the club in recognition of the Festival of Britain celebration in 1951 and allocated to the Mens 100 metres Breaststroke event.
- 1952 **Festival of Britain Trophy**  
Presented to the club by the Warrington Parks and Baths Committee to mark the Festival of Britain celebration. The trophy is allocated to the Senior Mens Swimmer of the Year.
- 1952 **Queen Elizabeth II Coronation Trophy**  
Presented to the club by the Warrington Parks and Baths Committee to mark the Coronation of Queen Elizabeth II. The trophy is allocated to the Senior Womens Swimmer of the Year.
- 1956 **Eugene Dell Trophy**  
Presented to the club by the family of Eugene Dell to mark his 50 years of service to the club. Although never holding office in the Club he was a long time supporter of the activities of the Club.
- 1959 **R.W.Cook Challenge Cup**  
Presented to the club by Mr.R.W.Cook, a well-known Estate Agent in Warrington at that time.
- 1959 **Ada Clegg Trophy**  
Presented to the club by Mrs Ada Clegg, daughter of Mr.R.W.Cook. Allocated to the Girls 100 metres Individual Medley championship but withdrawn in 1975 due to excessive damage that could not be repaired.
- 1959 **A.Clegg Trophy**  
Presented to the club by Mrs Ada Clegg, daughter of Mr.R.W.Cook. Allocated to the Senior Womens 200 metres Individual Medley championship.
- 1966 **Clayton Challenge Cup**  
Presented to the club by Mr. and Mrs. J.G.Clayton. Both Mr. and Mrs. Clayton were for many years members of the General Management Committee of the club and Mr. Geoffrey Clayton held the office of Chairman of the club in 1974 and 1975.
- 1967 **Rathmill Challenge Cup**  
Presented to the club by Mr. and Mrs J.R.Rathmill. For many years Mrs. B Rathmill was a member of the then Ladies Committee and Mr. J.R.Rathmill is a member of the General Management Committee of the club. Presented to the club by Mr. and Mrs. Savage.
- 1973 G.E.Massey Cup  
Presented to the club by Mr. and Mrs. G.E.Massey. For a number of years Mrs. Massey served on the then Ladies Committee of the club.
- 1973 Buckley Challenge Trophy  
Presented to the club by Mr. and Mrs. F.Buckley. Mrs D.Buckley served on the General Management Committee of the club for many years and held the position of Chairman of the club in its Centenary year of 1979 and in 1980. Mrs. Buckley was elected a Life Member of the club in 1980.
- 1974 William Henry Ellis Memorial Trophy  
Presented to the club by Mr. Roy Ellis in memory of his father. Although never seeking office in the club William 'Bill' Ellis was an active member of the club over a very long period of time and was actively engaged in teaching swimming right up to his death in 1974.
- 1975 R.A.Clayton Trophy  
Presented to the club by Mr. and Mrs. R A Clayton. For a number of years both Mr. and Mrs. Clayton were members of the General Management Committee of the club. Mr. Alan Clayton held the office of Chairman of the club in 1976.
- 1975 A.W.Taylor Trophy  
Presented to the club by Mr. and Mrs. A.W.Taylor. Mr. Taylor was a member of the General Management Committee of the club for a number of years up to his death in 1981.
- 1979 Centenary Challenge Trophy  
Presented for competition by the General Management Committee of the club to commemorate the centenary of the club in 1979 and allocated to the Girls 14 years 100 metres Freestyle.
- 1980 Jack Bayley Trophy  
Presented to the club by Jack Bayley to commemorate his long association with the club, spanning a period of over 50 years, at the time of the presentation of the trophy. Winner of the club freestyle championship in 1930 and for many years a well known water polo player, Jack Bayley also served as a member of the General Management Committee of the club and as the Water Polo Secretary from 1954 to 1975. He represented the Warrington Swimming Club on the Executive Committee of the Northern Counties Amateur Swimming Association, the Cheshire County Water Polo and Swimming Association and the Liverpool and District Swimming and Water Polo Association. Made a Life Member of the club in 1961 in recognition of his outstanding service he remained active in swimming right up to his death in 1991. Presented to the club by Mr and Mrs Ashton in memory of Mr Ashton's Grandfather. Mr and Mrs Ashton have a son and daughter who both swam for the club.
- 2000 Ethel Eaton Memorial Trophy  
Presented to the club by Mr Ken Eaton, the Chief Swimming Coach, in memory of his mother.
- 2001 Tom Eaton Memorial Trophy  
Presented to the club by Mr Ken Eaton, the Chief Swimming Coach, in memory of his father who died in 2001.
- 2002 Barbara Brand Trophy  
Presented to the Club by Mrs. Barbara Brand, the Mother of Mrs. Sue Tahraoui and Mrs Jane Tahraoui and the Grandmother of the Taharoui children who swim and play water polo for the club.
- 2002 Charles Brand Trophy  
Presented to the Club by Mrs. Barbara Brand in memory of her husband Charles.
- 2003 Dr A and Mrs Y J Boyle Trophy
